Re : **Appointees to the 2010 CGSA Nominating Committee**

The CGSA Board of Directors is made up of ten members including the President, Immediate Past President, Vice President and representatives from the British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Ontario, Quebec and Atlantic “regions.”

Annually, the term of approximately half of the regional representatives to the Board of Directors comes to an end and a CGSA Nominating Committee is charged with the responsibility of putting forward a slate of candidates for consideration by the members at the Annual General Meeting (AGM).

The 2010 Annual General Meeting will be held on Monday, March 1st, in Toronto, Ontario. The positions that are subject to election at that time include those of President, Vice President and the Directors from the Manitoba, Ontario, Quebec and Atlantic regions. The President and Vice-President positions are for one-year terms and each regional director position is for a two year term.

CGSA is requesting that your association put forward the name of an individual to serve as a member on the CGSA Nominating Committee. As a committee member, this person is not eligible to be a candidate or to be elected to the Board of Directors of CGSA for 2010. Please provide the name of your representative by **January 8, 2010**. The Nominating Committee will meet prior to the conference, but only if necessary. Any meetings will be conducted by conference call. A meeting will only be necessary if the number of candidates exceeds or is less than that required for each office that is subject to election.

On December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009 or earlier, CGSA will advise all members that are eligible to be elected that nominations are open for the available positions. The current regional representatives to the Board of Directors are eligible to stand for re-election.

At the March 1, 2010 Annual General Meeting of the Canadian Golf Superintendents Association in Toronto, Ontario the position of Regional Director for the Quebec Region will be subject to election. The term for this position is March 1, 2010 – March 1, 2012.

CGSA encourages you to choose the best individual from among CGSA member superintendents in your area, who also has the support of the provincial and other area associations, and that you feel will best represent the profession.
